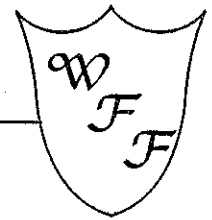

Scholarship Application

The Weeks Family Foundation is an annual scholarship program for a graduating senior in one of six area school districts: Albion, Barker, Lockport, Newfane, Royalton-Hartland and Starpoint. Each year, one student is selected who most represents the ideals espoused by the Foundation. This scholarship is valued at \$1,000.00 per year, for up to four years at a two-year and/or four-year accredited college or university following graduation from high school.

This scholarship will be awarded to an outstanding student who, in the opinion of the Foundation, is of exemplary character and motivation, displaying an impact on his or her peers and the community. No special emphasis shall be placed on any one factor of the student's application, except for the essay, and the Foundation encourages any graduating senior to apply.

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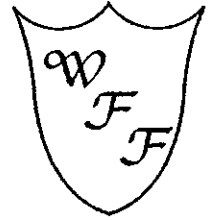

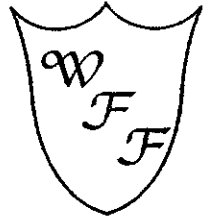

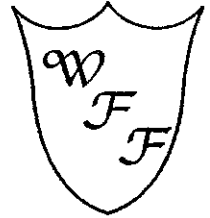
